In the G.O.first read above, the Government have constituted State Advisory Committee under sub section (6) of section (7) of the Pre-Natal Diagnostic Technique (R&PM)Act,1994 with the following members for the effective implementation of the Act.

2. In the reference second read above, the Government included Commissioner of Maternal and Child Health as the Member of the Advisory Committee.

The Government carefully examined the question of reconstitution of State Level Advisory Committee with a view to bringing the constitution of the Advisory Committee in line with the provisions of the Pre-Natal Diagnostic Technique (R&PM)Act, 1994 and to give fresh impetus to the Committee and have considered that it would be appropriate if the present four non-official members in the State Level Advisory Committee be substituted by three new members.
