CEMONC Activities (Part of Maternal and Child Health)

Tamil Nadu is ranked among the high-performing States in India, in the area of human development. The State is noted for its low mortality rates and effective healthcare services.

Over the last few decades, healthcare in the state of Tamil Nadu has improved significantly, with more people having increased access to medical care. The Tamil Nadu Health Systems Project (TNHSP), implemented by the Health and Family Welfare Department (Government of Tamilnadu), lent its support to the Health Policy of 2003 and focussed on improving the health status of people belonging to the lower socio-economic strata. Established in 2005, the Tamilnadu Health Systems Project, an initiative of the Government of Tamilnadu, in partnership with the World Bank, created a health system in Tamilnadu that is even now highly accessible, equitable and effective. The TNHSP structured on the following themes:

- Child health
- Indigenous peoples
- Health system performance
- ❖ Population and reproductive health
- Injuries and non-communicable diseases

CEmONC Concept started in 2004

An analysis of the maternal and infant mortality data revealed that 75% of maternal deaths occured during intra partum and post partum and 25% occured in antepartum. One common issue was that of referral. When the hospital where the

pregnant woman accessed for care did not have adequate facilities, she had to be referred to another hospital elsewhere. Covering the distance between two hospitals at such a critical stage could prove fatal, as it was usually the complicated cases that were referred to other hospitals especially in the rural areas.

Hence, it was decided to strengthen the obstetric and new born services in the hospitals which led to the creation of the 'Comprehensive Emergency Obstetric and Neonatal Care' Centres

Basic emergency obstetric and newborn care is critical to reducing maternal and neonatal

Towards this end the TNHSP started EmONCs and CEmONCs, throughout the length and breadth of Tamil Nadu in 3 phases, finally ensuring that no labouring mother needs to travel for more than half to one hour to reach an emergency comprehensive health facility.

In order to ease out this issue, the Government has issued orders in phased manner to establish CEmONC Centres in the State, during the year 2004.

In the first Phase-----48 centres (2005-2006)

In the second Phase-----32 centres (2006-2007)

In the third Phase-----28centres (2007-2008)

Were created.
